Papa Bear Child Care Centre is a new Christian Centre where we strive to create a safe, warm and healthy homely environment for the personal care and education of your children. Our qualified team of professional staff are caring individuals who believe in the Centre's philosophy and the importance of high level personal teacher interactions.

Our Early Childhood and Pre-school Learning Programs encompass all areas of development; Physical, Cognitive, Language, Social & Emotional. They are designed to help your child develop confidence and social skills, and prepare them for their future education. They will encourage your child to develop vital developmental skills by offering fun, creative, exciting and challenging opportunities and activities. Our two playrooms will cater for each age group:

Papa Bear Bubba Cubs: Oyrs- 2yrs Papa Bear Cubbys: 3yrs to 4yrs
Papa Bear Teddys: 2yrs to 3yrs Papa Bear Pre-School Cubs: 4yrs to 5yrs

As part of our Early Learning Program, your will receive a mid-year developmental report. An Annual Journal is compiled with your child's observations & crafts throughout their year at Papa Bear. It is a lovely reflection on your child's progress, interests & abilities, for you to treasure and share in the future.

Papa Bear Child Care Centre will be open from 7.00am - 6.00pm, Monday to Friday, 50 weeks per year. The Centre is closed on Public Holidays and over the two week Christmas/New Years period. Morning & Afternoon Tea and a fresh hot Lunch according to our Healthy Eating Menu, are prepared fresh daily on the premises. The only thing you'll need to bring each day is your child's bag with change of clothes, formula or any other substitute for milk for Bubba Cub and water bottle, a piece of fruit for our Fruit Bowl, and 3 nappies should your child not be toilet-trained - and of-course, any special item your child feels necessary to keep with them for sleep time.

Fees are due two weeks in advance at all times. Failure to comply will result in a review of your child's position. A 2-week bond is payable upon enrolment & refundable only <u>after</u> your child commences their enrolment, with all fees paid to date and a withdrawal notice period of 4 weeks is given. Fees are:

- Daily \$105 2-5yrs \$115 0-2yrs
- Initial Registration \$100 (incl. personal pack)
- Annual Registration \$60
- Late Pick up \$10 per 5 minutes

To claim your Child Care Benefit, call Centrelink-136150. We recommend this is done before your child commences, so we can calculate fees for your child's placement and can advise you of **your** exact daily rate.
